Dear Valued Supporter,

The second annual Collin Rose Memorial Golf Outing takes place July 23, 2018 at Cherry Creek Golf Club in Shelby Township. The event honors the late Wayne State University Police Officer Collin Rose who was murdered in November 2016 while on a street investigation in Detroit's Woodbridge neighborhood just southwest of campus. Rose served honorably and worked as a canine handler of both Clyde and Wolverine. He was passionate about working dogs with the Metro Detroit Schutzhund Club and rescuing homeless dogs and improving their quality of life through the Detroit Dog Rescue. He was a member of the department's honor guard and a participant in the annual Police Unity Tour memorial bicycle ride which recognizes fallen police officers and supports the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial.

The Officer Collin Rose Memorial Foundation was created to ensure our fallen hero is never forgotten. We are honored to further his legacy and support the initiatives and causes that he cared about. We obtained our letter of determination as a public charity from the Internal Revenue Service in August 2017 and are exempt from federal income tax under Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c) 3.

Proceeds from last year's sold-out outing helped us provide protective equipment for four police dogs and protective vests for another two police dogs. We also supported four riders in the Police Unity Tour and canine rescue organizations in Detroit and Kalamazoo County where Officer Rose grew up. We funded the public safety scholarship bearing Collin's name at his hometown high school. We advocated for the creation of Rose Dog Park in the neighborhood where Collin was murdered and supported the effort for a memorial medallion inside the park. We helped publicize the line of duty death of Detroit Police Officer Donald Kimbrough after he was left disabled by gunfire 45 years earlier. We are proud to ensure he was not forgotten and received a hero's funeral. We have supported 70 line of duty death survivors and tried our best to help temper their grief. More importantly our board of directors has been present with Collin's survivors at each court hearing and memorial event.
